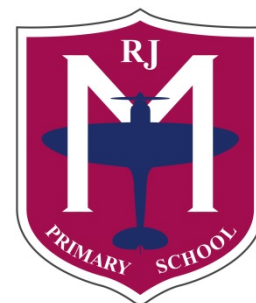


## Sports Funding Expenditure
